#### Disqualification

Any justified complaints received by PSLD automatically disqualify the candidate and prevent him from joining PSLD. If the candidate has all the necessary documents and no complaints have been recorded, he or she will be subject to a verification procedure. During it, the member's competences and his opinion in the detective community are checked. In case of inaccuracies, the candidate is invited to an interview which decides whether he is accepted or rejected.

#### Disciplinary procedures

In the case of complaints against detectives who are not members of the PSLD, we refer people to the Ministry of Interior and Administration, which is the competent authority to consider complaints. If necessary, we analyze the case and point out specific errors in the proceedings.

If the complaint concerned a PSLD member (such situations are unlikely to occur). The case is investigated by the PSLD disciplinary court and, if necessary, also by the court of a PSLD colleague. If violations are found, we may draw a number of consequences, including removal from the list of PSLD members
