Security Cooperation : the next step ?

The French security industry regulators, who also manage private investigators in France, have made minor changes to the organization of the controlling body, the CNAPS.

The Ministry of Interior also changed the former DISP into a "Delegation Aux Cooperation de Securite", a specialized body for public/private security cooperation.

The regulation and licensing process has come to an end in France. And all professionals legally allowed to practise have been delivered with a licence number.

The figures are now available and its turns out only 650 P.I. licences have been given by the state so far.

SNARP is proud to be the only P.I. association in France to be represented at the National College made up of 28 members, chaired by Alain BAUER, acting as a management board but also in the National Licensing and Inspection Commission (CNAC) that oversees compliance with the general guidelines set by the College and harmonization of the decisions of the regional Commissions.

Finally members of the SNARP are also sitting in the 12 Inter-regional or Local Licensing and Inspection Commissions (CIAC/CLAC)

The latest CNAPS report in English is attached and it may be of interest to other IKD members.
