Description

FSPD was founded in 1952 by the name of "Vereinigung Schweizerischer Privat-Detektive (VSP)" in Zurich. In 1970, the association was renamed into its current name. Together with the German (BDD) and the Austrian (ÖDV) association, FSPD was a co-founder of IKD in 1964.

Members benefit from the association's high repute in public (politicians, lawyers etc.) and from further services the association provides to its members (information sharing, homepage, membership directory, annual general meeting etc.).

The association's board consists of the president, the secretary, the treasurer and two to three assessors. Its meetings take place two to three times a year. The members of the board are elected every two years on the occasion of the annual general meeting, normally in June.
